HOW TO REACH THE CONGRESS CENTRE

BY CAR

The Veneto Region is well connected with the rest of Italy by an excellent motorway network.

Verona is easily reached by all means of transport at a crossroad for routes serving central and north-western Italy.

- A22 motorway: exit at "Verona Nord", then take "Tangenziale Sud" (Vicenza direction) to Verona, take exit n. 6 for Alpo and follow the signposts for "Fiera"; distance: 7 km.
- A4 motorway: exit at "Verona Sud" and follow the signposts for "Fiera"; distance: 1 km.

BY PLANE

Valerio Catullo Airport is only about 12 km from the Exhibition Centre and operates daily connections between Verona and the main Italian and European cities. www.aeroporto.verona.it

BY TRAIN

North-south and east-west routes are similar to the motorway system. The most important routes are served by fast trains serving the main cities in the Veneto Region with other main Italian cities. For abstract submission please visit the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION CENTRE at the web site: <http://ab-stract.evsrl.it/>. The system will help you while filling the fields. In order to access to the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION CENTRE, you need to register to the EGO System first: you can visit the EGO Home Page at the link <http://ego.evsrl.it/>. Username and password will be sent in 2 working days.

To submit your abstract to the ABSTRACT SUBMISSION CENTRE you have to complete the following blanks:

1. WORK / ABSTRACT TYPE
2. TITLE
3. INTEREST AREA / SUBJECT-TOPIC
4. ADDRESS FOR CORRESPONDENCE
5. AUTHORS
6. TEXT AND ESSENTIAL BIBLIOGRAPHY

N.B.: maximum 5400 characters including spaces (unbreakable).
The blanks Title, Interest area, Authors are not included in 5400 characters.
Graphs, images, tables and photos will not be published.

WORKS WHICH ARE NOT INCLUDED IN ANY OF THE SPECIALIST AREAS OF THE CONGRESS - OPHTHALMOLOGY - WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE TEXT MUST NOT CONTAIN ANY REFERENCE TO THE AUTHORS OR /AND TO THE FACILITY WHERE THE WORK WAS MADE. IF THIS OCCUR, THE ABSTRACTS WILL BE REJECTED.

SUBDIVISION IN CHAPTERS

In case your abstract is an original research, it must be parted in the following chapters: Aim of the work, Materials, Methods used, Results and Conclusions.

For clinical cases: Introduction, Case Description and Discussion.
Abstracts that do not comply with this format will be refused automatically. The statement "Results will be discussed" is not acceptable.

ETHICAL STANDARDS

The **non**-experimental researches must be approved in advanced by an ethics committee. Case reports and retrospective researches don't usually need to be approved by an ethics committee, but the Congress Scientific Committee reserves the right to request the approval of those kind of abstracts and of other works which entail the use of living animals. If animals were used from private owners, the author must document the obtaining of informed consent from the owners. **Experimental** works must be approved by the cognizant authority according to the current regulations. The online application for will ask the author to confirm that you have those documents. If necessary, the organiser reserves the right to ask the

author to provide them. The abstracts that do not comply with these rules will be rejected.

CONGRESS REGISTRATION

THE AUTHOR/SPEAKER OF AN ACCEPTED WORK WILL RECEIVE A FREE FULL REGISTRATION. (Registration at the Congress, Pre-registered sector).

EVALUATIONS AND DEADLINES

The abstracts must be sent within **JANUARY 18th, 2019**.

The works cannot be modified and can only be accepted or refused.

The abstracts which will be sent after JANUARY 18th, 2019 will not be accepted in any way.

When possible, the abstracts will be evaluated by diplomats of Veterinary European College corresponding the topics presented.

The system does not accept works after 24:00 (CET) of the day fixed as deadline.

PLEASE DO NOT FORGET THAT THE DEADLINE REFERS TO ITALY TIME ZONE. The abstracts will be evaluated and the authors will be informed by e-mail within **FEBRUARY 8th, 2019**.

LANGUAGE AND TIMING

Short Communications have to be presented in English or Italian.

Timing for Short Communications presentation: FIFTEEN (15) minutes, including the time for the discussion.

POSTER PRESENTATION

Posters will be considered in case of exceeding number of accepted free communications. The authors have to be available for questions and answers time during the coffee breaks. The poster has to be 1.30 meters high and 0.80 meters wide.

The title, author or authors and their affiliation must be clearly visible and printed in at least 5 cm high characters. The text of the poster must respect the text of the short communication and be readable from a distance of at least 1 meter. The posters will be attached to specific supports. When possible, the results should be presented with graphs and images.

The accepted Short Communications and posters will be included in the Proceedings of the Congress.

The author/speaker of the accepted short communications and posters will receive a free registration to the Congress.
