

#### CONGRESS REGISTRATION

#### CANCELLATION POLICY AND REFUNDS

Cancellation requests must be received in writing, either via email to info@scivac.it or by fax to 0039 0372 403512 within 30 April to get refunded 75% of the registration fee. Registrations cannot be refunded after that time.

BY 30 APRIL 2020: refund of 75% of paid fee.

AFTER 30 APRIL 2020: no refund will be made.

The date on the fax or e-mail or postmark will be a proof of conveyance. All refunds will be done after the Congress.

If, for reasons entirely beyond the control of the organizer, the Congress should be cancelled, the registration fee will be refunded after deduction of unavoidable expenses.



The badge is sent via e-mail a few days before the congress only to participants who are pre-registered. Download and priting out of the personal ID badge can be done throughout a dedicated link. The congress badge allows to directly access the check-in areas and skip the queue.

#### HOW TO REACH RIMINI **BY AIR**

Bologna's International "Guglielmo Marconi" airport is approximately 100 km away from Rimini by motorway and can be reached in one hour, both with shuttle buses or private vehicles. It guarantees daily links with major Italian, European and international cities, served by the main international airlines. For further information: www.bologna-airport.it

#### **BY CAR**

Thanks to the motorway network, Rimini is well connected with the rest of Italy and Europe It lies on the A14 Milano-Bari motorway, and is served by two exits: Rimini Nord and Rimini Sud. With the A14, from Rimini it is easy to reach the A4 to Venice and the A22 to the Brenner pass. Florence, Rome and Naples are equally accessible with the A1 motorway.

#### **BY TRAIN**

The rail network also helps to link the Rimini Riviera with the rest of Italy. From Rimini station, just 1.5 km from the Palacongressi, you can conveniently reach also by high speed connections, Bologna in 1 hour, Milan in 2 hours and Rome in less than 4 hours. 
